

Tourist Guy

Status: Fake (composite)

Date: Circulating online since September 2001.

Millions of people shared this photo via email in the weeks following September 11, 2001. A caption claimed the photo showed, "A simple tourist getting himself photographed on the top of the WTC just seconds before the tragedy ... the camera was found in the rubble!!"

It was eventually learned that the image was the work of a Hungarian man named Peter Guzli. He had pasted an image of a plane (from a photo by Jonathan Derden which he had found online), into a snapshot of himself posing while visiting the World Trade Center's observation deck in 1997.








- the required knowledge level for performing modification of location and date/time is getting very low.



- reverse image search shall be improved in order to find original content easier (steganography, perceptual hash);






- authentic location and date/time data of GALILEO satellites have to be embedded (cryptography);

We see that...


• pre-verification will be needed instead of post-verification for successful fact-checking of photos and videos!





We see that...

• pre-verification would cover not just authenticating the content but also the content creator (eIDAS KYC/CDD)!
